Parents / Care Givers of Prospective Representative Players,

The following is a brief outline and expected costs involved, with your child Representing Tamworth Basketball in the Waratah Northern Junior League.

The year generally consists of four rounds (3 to 4 games per round) held on separate weekends at different locations. Which will consist of one home round and 3 away rounds with finals being in Port Macquarie.

Depending on the number of teams nominated in the WNJL, different divisions may play on the same weekend. Until the draw is finalised, please use the following costs as a guide only.

The approximate cost for 2019 will be somewhere between \$300-\$400 – to be confirmed when nominations and draws are finalised. Costs include, BNSW Fees & Levies (Games fees, Referees, Development), Coaches Levy, Equipment etc.

Training costs are not included in these fees.

Teams may also decide to compete at Country Tournament (June long weekend). Organisation and costs of attending extra events are the responsibility of each individual team and are not included in the NJL fees for the season.

Fundraising opportunities such as raffles will be available to individual teams.

If your child is selected as part of a Thunderbolt Team, a deposit of \$200 is required by December 10th 2018 to secure their selection. A final instalment will be due by March 1st 2019.

Dates and Venues for the 2019 season will not be finalised until February but games will commence in March with 1 round per month and finals July 27th/28th.

Venues will include Tamworth, Coffs Harbour, Port Macquarie and possibly Grafton, Newcastle/Central Coast.

- Please note: Tamworth Basketball are trialling a new program structure for 2019, there will be no travel & accommodation organised by the association. Players will travel privately to game venues and arrange their own accommodation.
